Dear Friends,

This report is perhaps the most important of all that I've sent out. Here, the inmates who are friends of Roger McGowen at the Wynne Unit in Huntsville, Texas tell us in their own words the significance and transforming power of the help we provide from the Roger McGowen International Support Group. This group is made up of three main organizations:

- -Association Suisse Roger W. McGowen (Pierre Pradervand Switzerland)
- -Les Amis de Roger McGowen (Pascal & Beatrice Bernard France)
- -Les Roses Sur Les Bitume (Bernard Montaud & Sanjy Ramboatiana France) (These organizations send funds to the Roger McGowen Fund Trust at Bank of America in the US from which I, as Trustee and Administrator, send funds to the inmates.)

Unlike the other reports, I encourage you to share this report with others – especially with those who might want to contribute funds to help produce these amazing results! To help us continue this work, I hope these letters will inspire the donation of more funds to the organizations mentioned above. A "Spread" is a prison word for a special gourmet meal prepared by inmates in their cells from items purchased at the commissary and shared with other inmates and usually 'spread' out on tables in the Day Room. Traditionally in the US these 'spreads' are a way to break the monotony of the terrible prison food and to create a sense of community among the inmates. Typically, the 'spreads' are small and done by gangs for their members or done by racially separate groups for those of their race: whites with whites, blacks with blacks etc.

While Roger McGowen was on death row, he started a tradition of always celebrating his birthday by finding a way to share a small 'spread' of snacks with everyone: White, Black and Hispanic inmates around his area. In the last six years - since leaving death row Roger started enlisting the help of several trusted inmate friends to receive the extra funds which I sent them so they could create a much larger 'spread'- and do it the last Friday of each month on his A-4 Cell Block. Word spread, and before long many at Wynne Unit wanted to be transferred to Roger's Cell Block to be a part of this transformed and friendly culture they had created there.

Finally, last November with the encouragement and extra funds from some French donors Roger recommended inmates on other Cell Blocks to receive extra funds from us and to put on their own 'Spreads'. The results have been astonishing and have led us to now fund these 'Spreads' on 5 different Cell Blocks (with up to 160 inmates each) and in one Dorm (of 40 inmates). The new warden, Rocky Moore, is supportive and has ordered the guards to allow the 'Spreads' to go on without interruption. If we have the funds, we plan to continue to support these monthly gatherings which are transforming the attitudes of inmates and officers and changing the entire culture at Wynne Unit for the better – with Black, White & Hispanic inmates all joining together with high-five's, hugs and friendly greetings that transcend race or former gang affiliation. Roger and I feel that we are creating an important model that could be replicated at other prisons. As Roger said, "Some of these guys are going to get out of prison, and we feel that what we are doing will help make them better people and someone you will be happy to have as your neighbor!

Here are a few of the letters I've received in December and January – many of the shorter ones were written on beautiful and creative hand-crafted greeting cards. Love, Ole! – Ro

Our support for presenting the "Spreads" of food for all to share:

The New Year's spread on C3 Block was better than before. This time we did it together. Everyone had their bowl on time and the ones who wanted a drink had a choice of blueberry or purple passion. We are getting better each time we get a chance to bring joy to the block with a spread. We had a chow line for real! Each course was so hot and ready that it still had smoke on it! Everything was set up beautifully. If we only could have taken a picture for your and our picture album! It was truly a family moment.

Ron, I wish you would have seen the faces of the ones that have been in prison a long time - they were so amazed and said that this was the first time they had witnessed something like this out of all those years they've been locked up in prison. They said they have never seen Black, White and Mexican come together – especially for a spread. We all gave God praise for making it possible. We also gave you thanks for letting God use you and the organization to be angels and saints for C3 Block – and also for the other Cell Blocks you help.

Once again, we had a good officer on the block. The first course was turkey, beef and cheese macaroni. Second course was a beefy meaty pizza. The third course was summer sausage meaty cheesy nachos! Drinks were Kool-Aid, Blueberry and Purple Passion.

Loving you is like food to my soul! Two things define a man in life: their patience when they have nothing and their attitude when they have everything. Keep that joy and love always in your heart my brother and have fun with it! Love and thanks!

My name is Sam Jones and I am a recipient of your generous donations. Thus, in essence we are slaves of the state government which in effect makes inmates totally dependent upon the prison to provide our daily needs. However, the Prison does not adequately provide for our daily needs (sometimes not at all)...such as, but not limited to deodorant, skin lotion, hair cream, mouthwash, etc. And for inmates like myself who are destitute and do not have any family sending us money to purchase these hygiene items we often fall into a cycle of despair, loneliness, and depression. But thanks to the benevolent supporters of Roger McGowen, I and other inmates like me who receive help from you guys are able to purchase the hygiene items needed along with food and a few snack items. And we are truly thankful for that.

I must give additional thanks to you guys for purchasing me a typewriter. I am a self-taught litigator (meaning no formal schooling). I file and litigate civil action lawsuits against the prison system on behalf of myself and other individuals in the prison population as well as litigating my own criminal conviction - trying to get my case overturned.
